



Challenge of the Americas

Event Supplemental

Mini Max –

- The MiniMax RPM Limiter is to be used during the Challenge of the Americas until further notice. One limiter will be issued to each Mini Max entrant and will be made available from Wednesday morning January 9, 2013 for use at the first event.
- The RPM Limiters will be organized for distribution by a representative from the MaxSpeed Group. This representative will be responsible for the distribution of the RPM Limiters and collection of the RPM Limiters at the conclusion of the event. Devices will be numbered, sealed, assigned and recorded to each competitor for use during this event.
- Use of RPM limit devices will be required for all on track sessions beginning Thursday, January 10, 2013 for remainder of event!
- The RPM Limiter will be supplied at each event at no charge to the competitor, and will be collected at the end of the event. These devices are not for sale at this time and are the sole property of the MaxSpeed Group.
- Device will be connected between wiring harness and ignition coil connections. It is highly recommended that the RPM Limiter be mounted on ignition coil with Velcro strap provided with device.
- Each RPM Limiter must be returned at the end of the event. If the RPM Limiter is not returned at the end of the event, a monetary penalty of \$250 per day will be issued by the MaxSpeed Group until the device is returned. Serious Challenge of the Americas series penalties will result for failure to return device at conclusion of final element on Sunday January 13, 2013 or a competitor's early departure from event! These penalties may be up to and include exclusion from all future Challenge of the Americas events.
- All RMCUS 2012 Mini Max gear ratio – tire size – carburetor – intake –exhaust restrictions are in effect.
